



**Rai S. Rana, Ph.D.**

**Dr. Rana** is chairman of Bio-links, the National Working Group (founded by him in 1996) for promoting implementation of the UN Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD). He is presently serving his second term as non-official member of the National Biodiversity Authority, India and also chairs its Expert Committee on Agricultural Biodiversity. He represents the Asia & Pacific region on Compliance Committee for the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety. He was also elected Co-chair of the FAO Commission on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (1993-1995) and assisted implementing CBD in eight countries in Asia, Africa and South America.

Former Director of the National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resources, Dr. Rana is widely known for developing India's National Plant Genetic Resources System and the present Campus of NBPGR and the National Gene Bank at New Delhi. He has worked for six years with leading NGOs engaged in biodiversity conservation, including WWF-India, IUCN, M.S. Swaminathan Research Foundation and the Gujarat Ecology Society. He chairs NBPGR's Research Advisory Committee and ICAR's Consortium Advisory Committee for implementing National Agricultural Innovations Project's Component-3 on Biodiversity Conservation and Livelihood Security in Fragile Ecosystems.

His research contributions to improving plant adaptation to saline environment and managing plant genetic resources have received wide appreciation. A Fellow of the National Academy of Sciences, India, Dr. Rana has received numerous recognitions including the IARI Jubilee Prize (1959), Indo-UK Exchange Award for Young Scientists (1968) and awards of National Fellow (1980), Professor of Eminence (1985) and Dr. H.B. Singh Memorial Award (2011-2012).
