The Intergovernmental Platform for Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES) is a newly established global independent intergovernmental body to provide for science policy interface on policy biodiversity. The goal of IPBES is to strengthen the science-policy interface for biodiversity and ecosystem services for conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity, long-term human well-being and sustainable development. The four main functions of IPBES are: (i) knowledge generation, (ii) assessment, (iii) policy support, and (iv) capacity building.
