NOTIFICATION

No. 926/EN/T-II-7/003-ii/2003.—16th April, 2018.—Whereas, Chilkigarh Kanak Durga Sacred Grove is a remnant forest with traditional beliefs and taboos of local inhabitants and rich in biodiversity covering an area of 55.9 metres, in Jhargram District of West Bengal;

And, whereas, to strengthen biodiversity conservation and to stem the rapid loss of biodiversity in the sacred grove, the State Government upon recommendation of the West Bengal Biodiversity Board has felt it necessary to declare the area as the Chilkigarh Kanak Durga Biodiversity Heritage Site;

And, whereas, the collection of species of plants, animals and microbes from the Chilkigarh Kanak Durga Biodiversity Heritage Site requires to be regulated as per the provisions of the Biological Diversity Act, 2002 and West Bengal Biological Diversity Rules, 2005;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section(1) of section 37 of the Biological Diversity Act, 2002 and Rule 20 of the West Bengal Biological Diversity Rules, 2005, the Governor is pleased hereby to declare the Chilkigarh Kanak Durga Sacred Grove as the Chilkigarh Kanak Durga Biodiversity Heritage Site.
